

Holistic Palliative Care (HoPE) Programme



Overview

The Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine at Nanyang Technological University, in partnership with National Healthcare Group, leads the way in Asia, to offer a stackable multidisciplinary postgraduate programme in Holistic Palliative Care (HoPE). This encompasses a Graduate Certificate, FlexiMasters, and culminates with a Master of Science (MSc) degree. Designed to resonate with local and regional cultural contexts, HoPE provides an opportunity for healthcare professionals to receive comprehensive training by a team of experts and achieve formal qualifications. Its modular design caters to working adults, offering varied entry and exit points, which allows new entrants to join the palliative care field and current professionals to further hone their skills. Given the ageing population trend in Asia and the evident need for specialised training in palliative care, HoPE is poised to substantially enhance the continent's palliative care landscape.

The main target student profile includes healthcare professionals wanting to transit from other healthcare domains to Palliative Care (PC), equipped them with foundational training in Palliative Care allowing them to apply and enhance their care for patients/residents in whichever current settings and existing healthcare professionals in PC who wish to upgrade their skills and capabilities.

- Healthcare professionals which includes nurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, pharmacists, medical social workers
- Doctors and other health professionals who meet the entry criteria

HoPE is a part-time programme and students can exit and re-enter the learning pathway within the maximum duration allocated for each sub-programme and the entire pathway.
